After serving ten years as UFCW Secretary-Treasurer, he was elected International President in 2014 — a role that marked the culmination of a lifetime devoted to lifting up workers and championing their rights. A national voice on retirement security, Marc played a central role in overseeing the UFCW's pension funds and ensuring our members could retire with stability and dignity.
